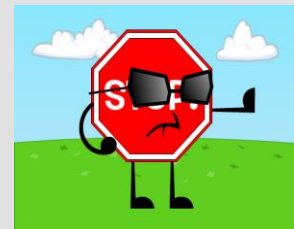
Thank you Stacia and Danielle for completing January and February Teacher Appreciation!
