Average Daily Attendance: A school's average daily attendance is calculated annually for the State of New Hampshire. State Adequacy payments for Charter Schools are calculated on enrollments numbers and attendance. Research has shown that schools should strive for as high as possible ADA to optimize student achievement and MACS closely monitors student attendance, watching for the warning signs of chronic absenteeism and truancy to assure that the necessary supports are put in place so attendance does not negatively impact a child's academic and future success.

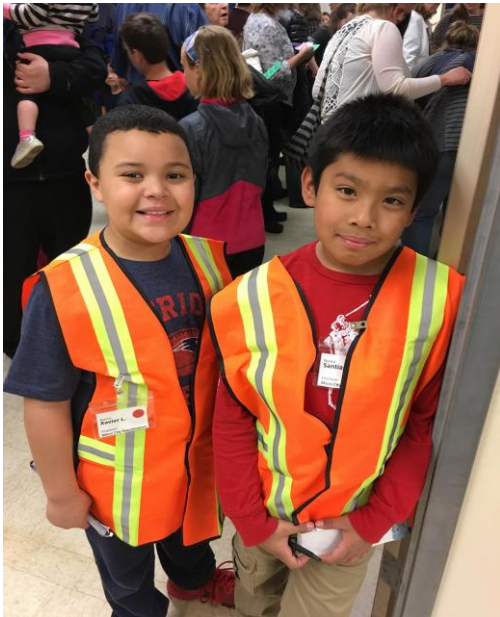
Charter School Aid:

Total aid per pupil in grades 1-5 is \$5,498

Total aid per pupil in Kindergarten is \$3,725

Charter School Per Pupil Aid is based on Average Daily Membership in Attendance. See RSA 194-B:11 for legislation that describes the calculation and distribution of aid. The Adequate Education Aid is calculated at least three times. The fourth payment is computed based on the total half-days membership reported on the End of Year Tuition Report. Aid due for the entire year will be calculated using a per diem rate. Then the first three payments will be subtracted. The resulting balance will be the final payment amount.

The average Cost per Pupil in a Traditional Public School as calculated by the NH DOE for the 2014/2015 school year for the State of NH was \$14,375.
