Upcoming/Recent Happenings at MACS:

Amy and the hiring committee have started conducting interviews and will continue until all open positions are filled. We hope to have the process all wrapped up before the school wraps up the year.

Amy and some members from the Board of Trustees will be attending the NH Board of Education meeting as part of the charter renewal process on May 9th. BOE members have received the DOE report regarding our renewal application and onsite visit and Amy and Board will be present to answer any clarifying questions they may have before determining our renewal status for the next five years.
