

## **Parent Board Seat Selection Policy**

**Approved - 12/13/2017**

The MicroSociety Board of Trustees maintains (2) two seats or 25%, whichever is greater per Bylaws, for the parents of current students of the MicroSociety Academy Charter School (MACS).

Parent seat terms run from nomination at the Annual Board Meeting in January through December of the calendar year. Per the Bylaws, all parent members of the Board of Trustees will serve one, one-year renewable term, to allow for the broadest representation of parents on the Board. Terms can be renewed by nomination and 2/3 vote of the Board.

In order to be eligible for consideration, the perspective parent representative must have had a child enrolled for one full school year. The child must also have a good attendance record for the parent to be considered for nomination of a one year parent board seat.

During the nomination period, if there is no other parent interest, and a parent board member received  $\frac{2}{3}$  majority vote, they may serve an additional year. If there is parent interest above and beyond the number of available parent seats, then interviews will be conducted by the board nomination committee for all interested parents. If the parent interest is beyond (5) five applicants, then all interested parent names will be brought to the MACS PTO. In turn, the MACS PTO will provide the board with no more than (5) five nominees who have completed application or letter of interest/resume. Of the parents forwarded by the MACS PTO to the nomination committee, all will be interviewed.
