### **Upcoming/Recent Happenings at MACS:**

Amy and Susannah are currently conducting teacher formal observations and evaluations through the months of February and March. We hope to wrap up the process by mid March.

Boston Billiards has approved us for 7 more days. We have been assigned February 5th-11th. We are again so grateful to be given this opportunity to receive significant funding through NH Charitable Gaming.

MACS has again been invited to a panel discussion on non traditional education with the Chamber of Commerce. Susannah will be representing MACS at this event this year.

Amy has been working with Fred C. Church on next year's liability and workmans comp plans and pricing. Amy and Lisa are meeting with Fred C Church and Health Trust to compare benefit options for staff contracts next year.
